"I took the theme of flowers, even though I work with flowers in an almost monstrous way. They are big flowers, masses of petals, tulips, and sunflowers," he added.

Granet draws inspiration from what he sees around him, whether it's flowers, vegetation, or everyday objects. These elements come to life in his paintings, which he often captures in photographs before translating them into his own style.

His works, varying in size and oscillating between abstraction and figuration, reveal a visual universe where nature and daily life blend in a whirlwind of vibrant colors and dynamic shapes.

"I like things that are both very abstract and very figurative, very different, very varied," he explained.
